Administrative Rule Hearing and Public Comment: Proposed Amendments to OAR 811-010-0110, Chiropractic Assistants

A public hearing is scheduled for May 17, 2012 at 2:00 p.m. before the Oregon Board of Chiropractic Examiners at the Morrow Crane Building, 3218 Pringle Rd. SE, Salem, Oregon, in the 2nd floor large conference room.

The proposed rule would set a “life” to applications of 12 months for chiropractic assistants, after which the applicant must re-apply. During this period the applicant can finish the process. The proposed amendments also specify that the \$25 application fee and the \$35 examination fee are non-refundable (regardless of circumstance). Written, faxed or emailed testimony is also accepted.
