

RULE SUMMARY

The proposed rules codify procedures necessary to implement House Bill 2329 which alters the definitions of Class I, II and III all-terrain vehicles and creates definition of Class IV all-terrain vehicle. The bill also exempts Class IV all-terrain vehicles from laws relating to vehicle registration, titling and accident reporting. The bill adds Class IV all-terrain vehicle to various offenses relating to all-terrain vehicles and creates offense of operation of Class IV all-terrain vehicle without driving privileges. The bill adds three members to All-Terrain Vehicle Advisory Committee.
